Compassionate Care

For those living with AIDS or other HIV-related illnesses, long-term, professional care is needed to preserve an individual's quality of life as they cope with their illnesses. Many prefer to receive their care in the privacy and comfort of their own home. Elant's HIV Home Care Program, a unique program in Dutchess County, focuses on the whole person. The program provides, directly or through contracted agreements with other agencies, a comprehensive offering of services to fill the client's medical, social, psychological and environmental needs.

If you or a loved one is living with Aids or is HIV-positive and a Dutchess County resident, Elant's HIV Home Care Program provides the high-quality, compassionate care you deserve. Admission to the program is based on the results of a detailed assessment and is available to both adults and children. Each client's personal and clinical information are kept strictly confidential.

Services

AT HOME

Elant's HIV Home Care program is approved by the New York State Department of Health, the Dutchess County Department of Social Services, Medicare, Medicaid and the AIDS Institute. The program offers support, as needed, in virtually every aspect of the client's life including:

- Professional nursing care including 24-hour on-call services
- Case management
- Pediatric care
- Personal care and home health aides
- Medical social workers
- Physical, occupational and speech therapy
- Medical supplies and equipment
- Nutritional counseling
- Home delivered meals

Paying For

Paying for care is seldom a barrier to participation in Elant's HIV Home Care Program. Elant accepts Medicaid, Medicare and private pay and will help clients qualify and complete the application for government HIV care funds that are available. These include services covered by the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP).

THE HIV UNINSURED CARE PROGRAM

The Elant HIV Home Care Program is one of the few agencies with access to the HIV Uninsured Care Program established by the New York State Department of Health/AIDS Institute. The funds cover skilled nursing care, home health aides, personal care services, medical equipment and laboratory tests. All services must be approved by the NYS Department of Health/AIDS Institute on a case-by-case basis.

ADAP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) provides payment for HIV-related medications for clients who cannot afford them or are waiting to qualify for Medicaid. Any NYS resident who has been diagnosed HIV-positive and meets financial eligibility requirements is eligible for ADAP funding.
